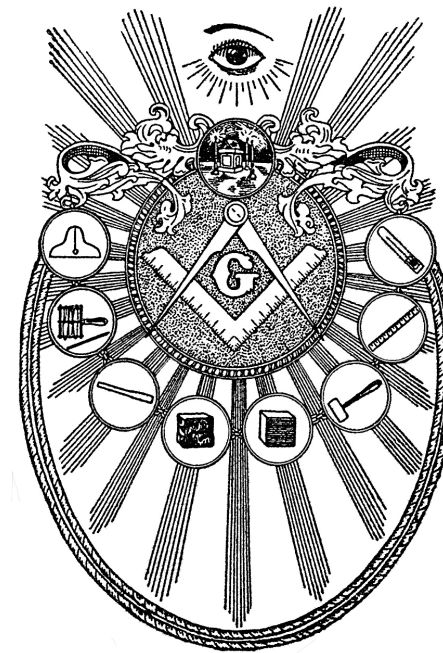

All Lodges should attend this event. Tools will be provided. Dress appropriately for this event.

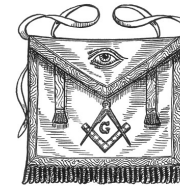
